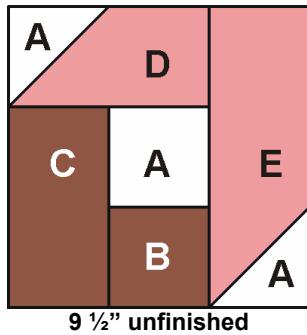

February Lotto Block
9" finished



- Start sewing pieces together by attaching an A piece to the B.
- Proceed as for a log cabin block adding each piece in alphabetical order through E.
- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the two F pieces. Place the F squares on the 2 medium corners, right sides together. (Stitch next to the drawn line on the side toward the corner.
- Press toward the corners. Trim the extra fabric layers to 1/4" seam allowance, if desired.

A & F = Cut 3 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Dark (

B = Cut 1 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

C = Cut 1 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Medium

D = Cut 1 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"

E = Cut 1 3 1/2" x 9 1/2"
