

• Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each D square. Place a green D on the corner of white E. Sew next to drawn line on the side toward the corner. Repeat for all four corners. Press toward corners and trim the seam allowance to 1/4".


• Join B pieces to the top and bottom of the unit you just completed.

• Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each A square. Place a white A on the top and bottom of each green C. Position so the drawn line tilts in the opposite direction at top and bottom of C. Sew next to drawn line on the side toward the corner. Repeat for the other C. Press toward corners and trim the seam allowance to 1/4".

• Join C units to the sides of the center unit.

• Embellish your wreath any way you like: embroidery, buttons, appliqué, ribbon, etc. Touches of red are especially nice.
