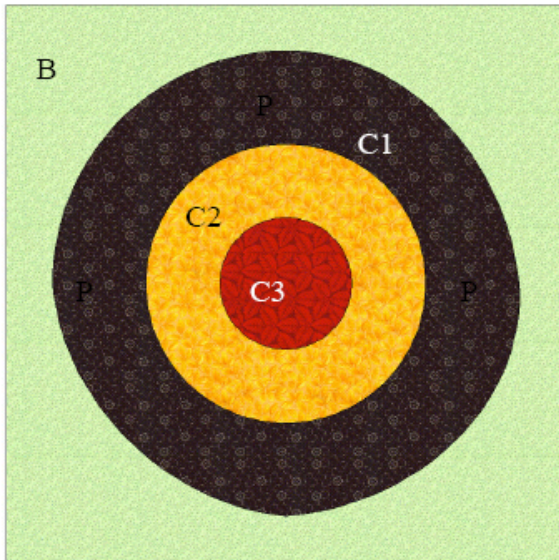


November Lotto Block



B = Background print (light)
C1, C2, C3 = Contrasting print 1, 2, & 3

- ✂ Cut 1 square 9" B
- ✂ Cut 1 square 8" C1
- ✂ Cut 1 square 6" C2
- ✂ Cut 1 square 4" C3

Fold the 8" square into eighths. Cut the point off the triangle at a curve to make a rough circle. Repeat with the 6" and 4" blocks.

Center the +/-8" circle on the 9" square, right sides up (not together). Sew around the circle a good 1/4" from the edge. Flip the block over and cut out the back from behind the circle, leaving 1/4" seam. Repeat sewing the +/-6" circle in the center and cutting out the back, and the +/-4" circle in the very center.

They can be cut in quarters, mixed up and sewn back together by the winner. (The raw edges are supposed to show.)
