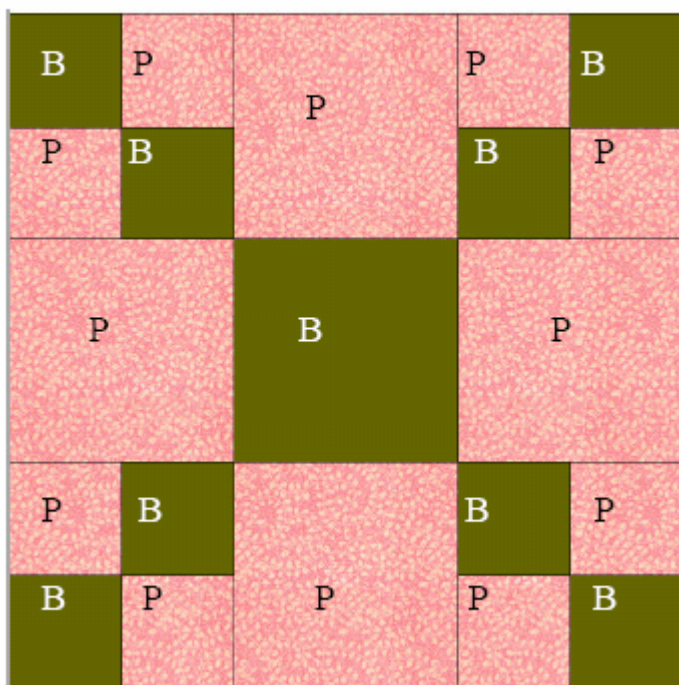


October Lotto Block



P = Soft or Light Pink print (no brights)

G = Greenish-Brown or Brownish-Green

-Cut 4 squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ " **P**

-Cut 1 square $3\frac{1}{2}$ " **G**

-Cut 1 strip each $2" \times 16"+$ **P&G**

Sew the two strips together iron toward the dark and cross cut them every 2" so you have eight pieces. Sew two together butting the seams at the center to make the 4-patches for the corners.

Arrange the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks and the 4-patches as shown. Sew three blocks together to make the rows then sew the rows together pressing seams opposite. The final block should measure $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Think of October's birthstones: OPAL and Pink
TOURMALINE when choosing the pinks and
forest colors for the green/browns.
