

Spring Cabin



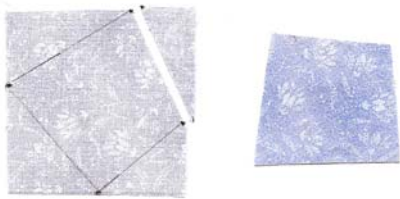
This cabin is built with pastel logs. The 4-sided center has no square angles (90 degree angles) and the logs may vary in width. Bring blocks to the April meeting.

Center: 3" pastel square

Fabric for Logs: Variety of pastel prints cut any width(s) between 1" & 2". Cut as needed to make unit large enough to cut an 8 1/2" square. There are no light or dark sides for this Spring Cabin block.

Method:

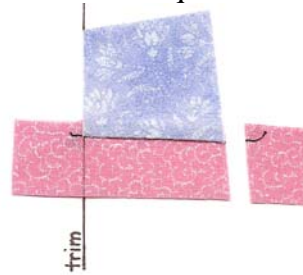
Start with 3" pastel square. On back, mark a random dot on edge of each of the four sides. Connect dots with ruler & cut (no right angles).



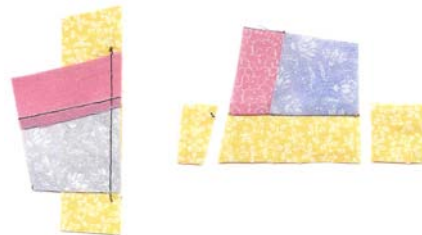
Place odd-shaped center, right side down, on first log leaving about 1" at start for trimming. Sew seam.



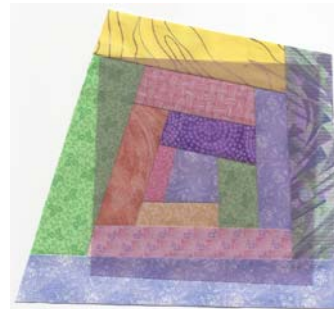
Press. Trim ends of log continuing straight line from center square.



Place unit on next log, right sides together, leaving about 1" at start. Sew; press; trim.



Continue adding logs in this manner around center patch until block is large enough to cut an 8 1/2" square (indicated by shaded area).



Cut 8 1/2" square trimming excess fabric from edges. Don't worry about grainline.
