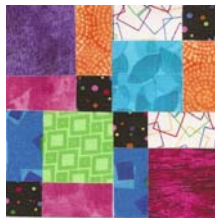


# A Whopper of a Block!

October Lotto Block



Finished Size: 17 1/2" square

## Fabrics:

(8) 6 1/2" squares-different contrasting "happy" colors (lights, mediums and darks).

(1) 6 1/2" square-black print.

*\*Please avoid busy prints.*

## Method:

1) Lay out 9-Patch in pleasing order positioning black in middle. Stitch block together with 1/4" seams; press.



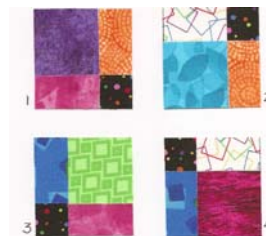
2) Cut **vertically** through middle of block, top to bottom, 3" from seamlines.



3) Cut **horizontally** through middle of block, left to right, 3" from seamlines.



4) You now have 4 sections. Turn squares **2 & 3** so black squares are in the **outside corners**. Do **not** turn squares 1 & 4.



5) Stitch squares together into a new block; press.



You may enter more than one block, but please use at least 5 different fabrics for your 9-Patch.

Below is a diagram of how these "Whopper Blocks" will look when sewn together!
