

## December 2011 Lotto Block

Choose 3 Christmas themed fabrics. At least one of the fabrics should be obviously Christmas. The other 2 should complement the theme.

1. Cut an 8" square from each fabric.
2. Place the 3 squares of fabric wrong side up in a stack on your cutting board.
3. Cutting through all 3 pieces at once, cut about a two inch piece off the bottom edge.
4. Cut this into 3 pieces with the middle piece becoming the 'trunk'.
5. Now, on the uncut piece, make a light dot about an inch down from the middle of the top edge and another dot about an inch in along the bottom left edge and again along the bottom right edge. Connect these dots as you cut through all three layers. The resulting triangle is the 'tree.'



6. Shuffle the 'tree' and 'trunk' stacks only, leaving the background consistent.
7. Sew the block together. DO NOT TRIM.

You have three completed lotto blocks. Your name is entered once for each block you enter.
