

February 2011 Lotto Block
Four Patch

Cut four 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares



Two should be "dark" and two should be "light" when compared within the group. Choose a blue fabric for at least one square.

Place 1 light sq and 1 dark sq, right sides together. Sew together with a scant ¼" seam and press the seam toward the darker fabric. Repeat with the other 2 squares. Lay the two units together, so the center seams nest against each other, or lock together. Check to make sure that a checkerboard, light-dark pattern is formed. Sew the units together with a scant ¼" seam and press the seam.

The unfinished block should measure 6 ½" x 6 ½".



Note: *If you choose to enter more than one block, please use a different combination of fabrics for each block.*
