

July 2011 Lotto Block
Patriotic Play on Rail Fence

Light that reads white -
2" x 13 ½"

Red -
2" x 13 ½"

Blue -
6 ½" square

Please be sure your red fabric has been prewashed to avoid possible bleeding problems. Light is a relative term so please be sure your light fabric reads white. Sew the red strip to the white strip. Square up the end and cut 2 pieces 6 ½" each. Sew together to form a rail fence type block measuring 6 ½" square. Press your seam allowances toward the red strips. Sew the blue square to the red and white block. The rails should run perpendicular to the blue block with the blue to the left and a red strip at the top of the rail fence type block. Visualize the United States Flag. ;) Press toward the blue field. Your block should now measure 6½" x 12 ½".

Note: *If you choose to make more than one entry, please use a different combination of fabrics for each 'block'.*
