

March 2011 Lotto Block
Double Four Patch

Cut two 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares
These should be dark
Cut eight 2" x 2" squares
Four should be "medium" and
four should be "light" when
compared within the group.
Choose a blue fabric for at
least one of the 10 squares.



Using the same method as
described last month, sew two
four patch units using the
eight small squares. Orient
the resulting 4 patch units with
the light fabrics forming a
diagonal line. Place the two
dark squares in the remaining
open corners and stitch the
new double four patch unit
together.



The resulting unfinished block should
measure 6 ½" x 6 ½".



Note: If you choose to enter more
than one block, please use a
different combination of fabrics for
each block.
