

October 2011 Lotto Block
Split Decision

Fabric #1

4 - 2" x 3 ½ " rectangles

Fabric #2

4 - 2" x 3 ½ " rectangles

Select your pieces from fabrics that contrast either in color, tone or texture. I can't get the picture to download from my camera, so I will give you a written diagram.

Make a column of two pieces of each fabric, alternating them fabric 1, fabric 2, fabric 1, fabric 2. Place your remaining two pieces of fabric 1 next to the first piece of fabric 1 that you set down, situated vertically at both ends of it. Place your remaining two pieces of fabric 2 next to the last piece of fabric 2 that you set down, situated vertically at both ends of it.

Stitch together the 3 columns, then stitch the columns together. Press your pieces to allow the seams to nest.

Your resulting unfinished block should measure 6 ½ " square.

Be sure to call me for help with this block, since I wasn't able to give you a picture diagram.

Note: *If you choose to make more than one entry, please use a different combination of fabrics for each block.*
