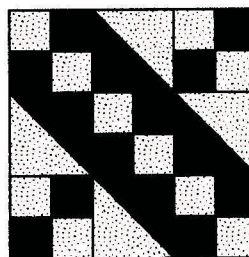


THE RAILROAD BLOCK

12 ½ INCHES unfinished

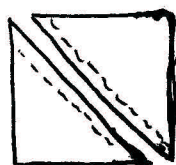
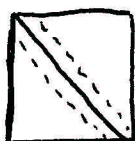
Choose one medium to dark blue print and one white on white or white background print.

From each fabric cut two 4- 7/8 inch squares and two 2 ½ inch strips, 13 inches long.



The Railroad
12" block

Right triangle units: Draw a diagonal line on the back side of the two white squares. Place the white square on the blue square right sides together. Sew ¼ inch away from both sides of the line. Cut on the drawn line. Press open to the dark. You will have 4 right triangle units.



Make 4.

4 patch units: Sew each white 2 ½ inch strip to a blue strip along the long edge (press to the dark). Place one strip unit on top of the other strip unit, opposite colors and right sides together. Make sure the center seams "nest" together. Cut five 2 ½ inch segments. Sew each segment together to make five 4-patch units.



Make 5.

Sew together the 4-patch units and the right triangle units to make a Railroad block as shown.
