

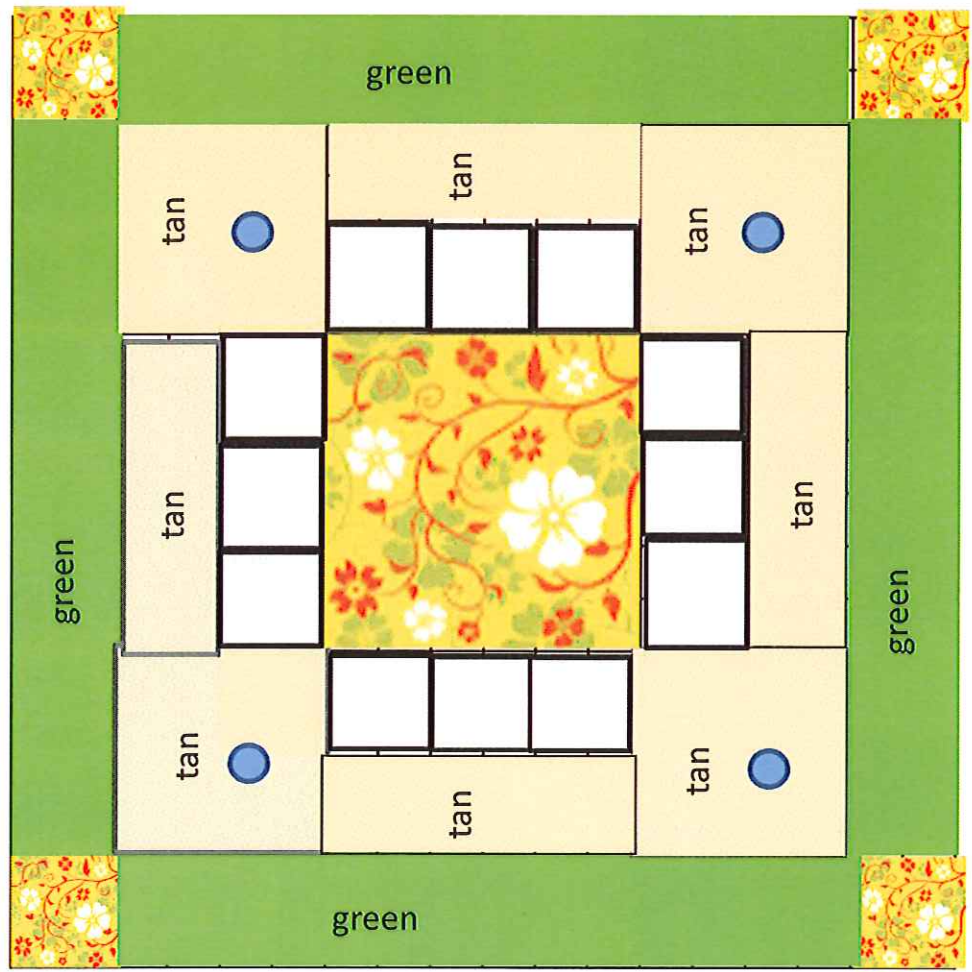
April 2013 Lotto Block: Wildflower Meadow
 (adapted from an American Patchwork and Quilting)

From a bright floral fabric, cut (1) 3 ½ " square & (4) 1 ½ " squares
 From med to dark green leafy, cut (4) 7 ½ x 1 ½ " strips

From light tan, cut (4) 2 ½ " squares & (4) 3 ½ x 1 ½ " strips

From a variety of fabrics, cut either (3) different 6 x 1 ½ " strips, OR for a scrappier look cut (12) different 1 ½ " squares.

Begin by stitching the three 6" strips together, then cut into (4) 1 ½ " sections, OR stitch 4 sets of 3 small squares together in a row. Sew these rows to the sides of the light tan 3 ½ " strips. Referring to the diagram, lay out the sections you have created with the light tan squares, and the larger floral square. Stitch together the middle section. Now sew a green strip to the top and bottom of the middle section. Sew a small floral square to each end of the other 2 green strips, and sew these to each side of the middle section to complete construction.
