Maple Star (from: 501 Rotary Cut Quilt Blocks, by Judy Hopkins)

Color Options

		1	2	3	4
A.	(1) 4 ¼" square Cut diagonally into 4 pieces (4) 2" x 3 ½" rectangles (4) 2" squares	Light pink	Med. pink	Light pink	Med. pink
B.	(4) 2" x 3 ½" rectangles	Med. pink	Light pink	Med. pink	Light pink
C.	(1) 3 ½" square (4) 2 3/8" squares cut diagonally into 2 pieces (4) 2" squares	Dark. red	Dark. red	Black	Black

Piece together color A and color C 2" squares – string piecing works well here.

Piece one C triangle on side of A triangle to start flying geese units. Press seams.

Note: press seam toward lighter square to get seams to nest.

Piece other C triangle on other side of A triangle to finish the flying geese units.

Press seams and trim.

Stitch color A rectangles to square/rectangles, paying attention to the orientation of the seams as shown in the diagram.

Stitch color B rectangles to flying geese units as shown. Press seams toward rectangular pieces.

Stitch these square units together in three rows as shown, then stitch the rows together to complete the block.
