

July 2013 Lotto Block: Ribbon Quilt (from 501 Rotary Cut Quilt Blocks, by Judy Hopkins)

Here's a simple red, white, and blue block to celebrate Independence Day. Finished size will be 9 inches.

From white, cut (4) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, and (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. From red and blue, cut (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares of each.

Draw a diagonal line on the backs of each of the $3\frac{7}{8}$ " white squares, pair them with the red and blue squares, and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of the drawn line. Cut on the line and press open to form (4) red and white, and (4) blue and white triangle/squares.

Lay your triangle squares and the solid white square out as a 9 patch, as shown, and stitch together to complete the construction of your block.
