## \#8 Big T

Bring this block to Sept meeting for the drawing

Cutting directions

LIGHT

DARK
MEDIUM

Cut eight rectangles, $2 \times 3$ 1/2" (flying geese \& frame around center)
Cut two 4 " squares (HST)
Cut two 4" squares (HST)
Cut eight 2" squares (flying geese)

HST = half square triangle
RST $=$ right sides together

Cut one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square (center)

1. HST: Pair up a light and dark 4" square, RST. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner. Sew a scant quarter inch on both sides of drawn line. Cut on drawn line. Repeat with remaining light and dark squares. You will have four HSTs. Square up to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
2. FLYING GEESE: Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of all medium $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Layer a square on one end of a light rectangle,(RST) as shown in Diagram 1. Sew on drawn line and
 trim away the outer triangle leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press triangle open (Diagram 2). Repeat with the other end of the light rectangle. Make four of these flying geese units.
3. Sew a light rectangle to the top of a flying geese unit (see Diagram 3), making 4 combination units (should measure 3 1/2").
4. Sew together as a 9-patch, orienting units as in above block diagram.
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
