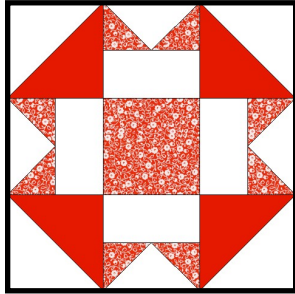


Quilters' Sew-ciety 2018 Red & White Lotto Blocks



#8 Big T

Finished block measures 9"

Bring this block to Sept meeting for the drawing

Cutting directions

- | | |
|--------|---|
| LIGHT | Cut eight rectangles, 2 x 3 1/2" (flying geese & frame around center) |
| | Cut two 4" squares (HST) |
| DARK | Cut two 4" squares (HST) |
| MEDIUM | Cut eight 2" squares (flying geese) |
| | Cut one 3 1/2" square (center) |

HST = half square triangle
RST = right sides together

1. HST: Pair up a light and dark 4" square, RST. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner. Sew a scant quarter inch on both sides of drawn line. Cut on drawn line. Repeat with remaining light and dark squares. You will have four HSTs. Square up to 3 1/2".
2. FLYING GEESE: Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of all medium 2" squares. Layer a square on one end of a light rectangle,(RST) as shown in Diagram 1. Sew on drawn line and trim away the outer triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press triangle open (Diagram 2). Repeat with the other end of the light rectangle. Make four of these flying geese units.
3. Sew a light rectangle to the top of a flying geese unit (see Diagram 3), making 4 combination units (should measure 3 1/2").
4. Sew together as a 9-patch, orienting units as in above block diagram.

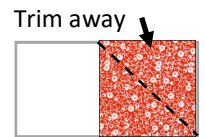
