## \#11 Shortcut to School

Bring this block to Dec meeting for the drawing

LIGHT Cut three 4" squares (HST)
Cutting directions

Cut four $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

DARK
Cut two 4" squares (HST)
Cut five $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Cut three $4 "$ squares (HST)

HST = half square triangle
RST $=$ right sides together

1. Make the center 9 -patch by sewing together the light and dark $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares—three rows of three squares each, arranged as shown in above diagram with dark corners. Sew rows together, pressing rows in alternating directions so they nest
2. Pair up a light and a dark 4 " square, RST. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner. Sew a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of drawn line. Cut on drawn line and press resulting two HSTs open, squaring up to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. You will have two HSTs.
3. Repeat Step 2, but pairing up a medium square with a dark. Again, you will have two HSTs.
4. Repeat Step 2, but pair up the two remaining light squares with the two remaining medium squares. You will have four HSTs.
5. Sew together into three rows of three units, arranging HSTs and the 9-patch as shown in diagram above. Press seams for the center row away from 9-patch and other two rows toward center.
6. Sew rows together.


This is an option for arranging and sewing blocks together: five rows of five blocks
