## \#12 Birds in Flight

Finished block measures 9"

Cutting directions

LIGHT Cut two 3 1/2" squares Cut three 4 " squares (HSTs)

DARK Cut two 4" squares (HSTs)

MEDIUM Cut one 3 1/2" square
MEDIUM Cut one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square Cut one 4" square (HSTs)

FINAL BLOCK!
Bring this block to Jan meeting for the final drawing

HST = half square triangle
RST $=$ right sides together

1. Pair up two light and two dark 4 " squares RST. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner. Sew a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of drawn line. Cut on drawn line and press resulting two HSTs open, squaring up to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. You will have four HSTs.
2. Repeat Step 1 but pairing up a medium 4"square with a light 4" square. You will have two HSTs.
3. Arrange HST units and squares as shown in block diagram above. Sew together into three rows of three units. Nest seams by pressing seams for the center row toward the center square, press other two rows away from center.
4. Sew rows together.


This is an option for arranging and sewing blocks together: seven rows of five blocks
