## \#7 Jacob's Ladder

Finished block measures 9"

NO LOTTO BLOCK DRAWING in AUGUST Bring this block in Sept when we will have 2 drawings for Aug \& Sept

LIGHT Cut one strip 2" $\times 21^{\prime \prime}$ (4-patches)
Cutting directions

Cut one strip 2" $\times 21^{\prime \prime}$ (4-patches)
Cut two $4 "$ squares (HST)
Cut one strip 2" x 21" (4-patches)
HST = half square triangle
RST $=$ right sides together

1. With RST, sew light strip to dark strip along the length. Press seam to dark. Subcut into ten $2^{\prime \prime}$ segments.
2. Pair up two segments and sew together to make 4-patch (see diagram for placement of light \& dark squares). Make five 4 -patches which should measure $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
3. Pair up a light square with a medium square, RST. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner. Sew a scant
 quarter inch on both sides of drawn line. Cut on drawn line. Repeat with remaining light and medium squares. Square up to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
4. Sew together as a 9-patch (see block diagram above for orientation of the units)
