
## Quilters' Sew-ciety 2018 Red & White Lotto Blocks



Finished block measures 9"

Bring your blocks to the July picnic where we will have 1 drawing for all of the month's entries

Cutting directions


HST = half square triangle QST = quarter square triangle RST = right sides together

- LIGHT
   Cut four 3 1/2 squares (corners)

   Cut one 4 1/2" square, cross cut twice on diagonal
   Image: Cut two 4 1/2" squares, crosscut once on diagonal

   DARK
   Cut two 4 1/2" squares, cross cut twice on diagonal
   Image: Cut one 4 1/2" square, (QST) cross cut twice on diagonal

   MEDIUM
   Cut one 4 1/2" square, (QST) cross cut twice on diagonal
   Image: Cut one 3 1/2" square (center)
- 1. Star Points—QST units—Pair a medium triangle with a light triangle and sew together on the bias edge (see diagram 1). Repeat to make 4 units
- Pair a dark triangle with a medium/light triangle unit from Step 1. Sew together on bias edges (Diagram 2). Repeat to make 4 units. These units will be slightly oversized. Square up to 3 1/2".
- 3. Sew units together into rows and then sew rows together, as shown in above block diagram.
