
Quilters' Sew-ciety 2018 Red & White Lotto Blocks



#10 Nine by Nine

Finished block measures 9"

Bring this block to Nov meeting for the drawing

Cutting directions

LIGHT Cut two strips 1 1/2" x 16"

Cut one strip 1 1/2" x 9"

DARK Cut one strip 1 1/2" x 16"

Cut two strips 1 1.2" x 9"

MEDIUM Cut four squares 3 1/2"

- 1. Sew the light 16" strips to both sides of the dark 16" strip to form one strip set. Press seams toward the dark. Crosscut into ten 1 1/2" segments.
- 2. Sew the dark 9" strips to both sides of the light 9" strip to form one strip set. Press seams toward the dark. Crosscut into five 1 1/2" segments.
- 3. Make five 9-patches from the strip set segments, with light corners (see diagram above). These 9-patch units should measure 3 1/2" unfinished.
- 4. Sew the small nine patches together with the medium 3 1/2" squares, alternating, to make three rows of three as shown in diagram above (small 9 patches in the corners). Press seams toward medium squares. Sew rows together.

2018 QS Red & White Lotto blocks.

- Use red and white/cream fabrics for all blocks
- All blocks should finish at 9"
- Make as many blocks as you want, more blocks = more chances to win
- Bring blocks to the meeting
