- \_\_\_\_\_ \* Fabrics for practice.
  - several fat quarters (or similar for backgrounds, and for circles)
- \_\_\_\_\_ \* Sewing machine with quarter inch sewing machine foot
  - (or other open toe foot)
- \_\_\_\_\_ \* Basic sewing machine supplies (needle, thread, scissors, seam ripper)
- \_\_\_\_\_ \* Rotary cutting equipment (cutter, small mat and rulers)
  - 6” x 12” and 12” x 12” are good sizes.
- \_\_\_\_\_ \* Glue-Baste (Roxanne’s) with the long needle nose applicator (the brand is not important, but the needle nose is)
- \_\_\_\_\_ \* Freezer paper
- \_\_\_\_\_ \* Blue painter’s tape (3/4” or 1”)
- \_\_\_\_\_ \* Paper cutting scissors
- \_\_\_\_\_ \* Marking pen or pencil
- \_\_\_\_\_ \* Something to draw circles – compass, Olfa circle cutter, or CD’s, plates, cups, etc. to trace around. Circles can be anywhere between 5” and 8”.

I will provide irons (with and without steam) and ironing surfaces.
